

Class 1: Introduction to Predictive Astrology: Plan & Exercises

Week 1:

Day 1: Read Lesson 1.1: Glyphs.

Do: Memorize the symbols and practice writing them throughout the week. You should be able to know what a glyph stands for without having to look it up.

Suggestion: Copy the symbols to flashcards to help you learn them quicker.

Day 2: Read Lesson 1.2: Zodiac Wheel.

Do: Perform the exercise outlined in this lesson.

Suggestion:

Try plotting more locations on the Zodiac wheel. Some you can try: 4 degrees Taurus, 18 degrees Virgo, 26 degrees Scorpio, 14 degrees Capricorn.

Day 3: Read Lesson 1.3: Reading an Ephemeris.

Do: Study the 2016 ephemeris on astro.com. Notice the symbols for the signs and planets. Understand the placement of each planet each day.

Watch the video for how to read an ephemeris.

Suggestion:

Perform this exercise to help you learn how to find points on an ephemeris.

On the 2016 ephemeris, on what date is:

The Sun at 7 degrees 30 minutes Libra?

Mercury at 14 degrees 4 minutes Cancer?

Mars at 20 degrees 40 minutes Scorpio?

Jupiter at 21 degrees 26 minutes Virgo?

Pluto at 16 degrees 9 minutes Capricorn?

Day 4: Read Lesson 1.4: Charts.

Do: Create the chart for Person A yourself on astro.com to get a feel for how to create charts. You can use the video on the [Free Astrology Courses](#) page on The Dark Pixie Astrology to help.

Suggestion:

Try creating your own natal chart and find the location of your 10 planets and 12 houses.

Days 5-7: Read Lesson 1.5: Basic Definitions.

Do: Memorize what the planets, houses, and signs rule, how they are divided up (element, modality, house type), and how they link up (by sign, house, and planet).

Suggestion:

Take the following short quiz (answers are at the end of this plan):

- 1) In transit, what does the Sun rule?
- 2) In transit, what does Mercury do?
- 3) In transit, what does Saturn rule?
- 4) What is Libra the sign of?
- 5) What is Capricorn the sign of?
- 6) In prediction, what do aspects to the 2nd house impact?
- 7) In prediction, what do aspects to the 9th house impact?
- 8) What are the four elements?
- 9) What are the three qualities?
- 10) What are the three house types?

Week 2:

Day 1: Read Lesson 1.6: Planetary Movement through the Houses.

Do: Follow along with the exercise in the lesson. Make sure to use the ephemeris on astro.com.

Suggestion:

Perform this exercise: Write down the planetary movement through the houses by transit Venus and Mars in 2016 for Person A. Answers are at the end of this plan.

Day 2: Read Lesson 1.7: Aspects.

Do: Memorize the distances of each aspect, what signs make what aspect to one another, and the energy of each aspect.

Suggestion:

Take this short quiz (answers are at the end of this plan):

- 1) What aspect are Aries and Libra to one another?
- 2) What aspect are Taurus and Leo to one another?
- 3) What aspect are Taurus and Scorpio to one another?
- 4) What aspect are Gemini and Libra to one another?
- 5) What aspect are Cancer and Virgo to one another?
- 6) What aspect are Taurus and Gemini to one another?
- 7) What aspect are Cancer and Aquarius to one another?
- 8) What aspect are Leo and Scorpio to one another?
- 9) What aspect are Scorpio and Pisces to one another?
- 10) What aspect are Sagittarius and Capricorn to one another?

Days 3-5: Read Lesson 1.8: Calculating Aspects.

Do: Follow along with the exercise in the lesson for Person A's aspects by the transit Sun to their natal Sun.

Suggestion:

Perform this exercise: Find the aspects made by transit Venus and Mars to Person A's natal Sun for all of 2016. Answers are at the end of this plan.

Days 6-7: Read Lesson 1.9: Orbs.

Do: Memorize about how long the orb of influence lasts for each planet.

Suggestion:

Perform this exercise: Write down what the orb of influence is for each of Person A's natal planets using a 2 degree orb. Find the dates for orb of influence for any aspects made by transit Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto to Person A's natal Moon in 2016 (if any). Answers are at the end of this plan.

The Sun - September 30th

Mercury - July 6th

Mars - February 12th

Jupiter - February 11th in retrograde, July 28th

Pluto - February 2nd, July 10th in retrograde, December 18th

Lesson 1.5:

- 1) Areas where you'll shine, get recognition, feel most like yourself, or feel most comfortable.
- 2) Shows where your mental focus will be.
- 3) Shows where you'll need to become more responsible and mature, learn lessons and grow, get punished for bad behavior and dumb choices, and you can get great rewards from Saturn (usually toward the end of the transit) if you learn, grow, and behave responsibly.
- 4) Committed relationships and partnerships
- 5) Ambition, goals, and achievement
- 6) How a person feels about themselves, as well as their finances
- 7) Legal dealings, your attitude toward your beliefs, whether you want to learn more about the world, and getting an education
- 8) Fire, Earth, Air, Water
- 9) Cardinal, Fixed, Mutable
- 10) Angular, Succedent, Cadent

Sun - 0 degrees 53 minutes - 4 degrees 53 minutes

Moon - 15 degrees 45 minutes - 19 degrees 45 minutes

Mercury 7 degrees 11 minutes - 11 degrees 11 minutes

Venus - 14 degrees 3 minutes - 18 degrees 3 minutes

Mars - 28 degrees 18 minutes (of the sign before since Mars is 0 degrees) -
2 degrees 18 minutes

Jupiter - 29 degrees 29 minutes (sign before) - 3 degrees 29 minutes

Saturn - 13 degrees 43 minutes - 17 degrees 43 minutes

Uranus - 11 degrees 33 minutes - 17 degrees 33 minutes

Neptune - 0 degrees 36 minutes - 4 degrees 36 minutes

Pluto - 27 degrees 34 minutes - 1 degree 34 minutes (of next sign since
Pluto is at 29 degrees)

Dates for orb of aspects to Person A's Moon:

Jupiter square February 26th - March 29th and June 20th - July 18th

Jupiter trine November 24th - December 20th

Saturn conjunct February 26th - April 23rd, November 13th - December
18th

Uranus trine to start the year until March 28th

Pluto semisextile January 1st - July 27th, November 24th to the end of the
year
